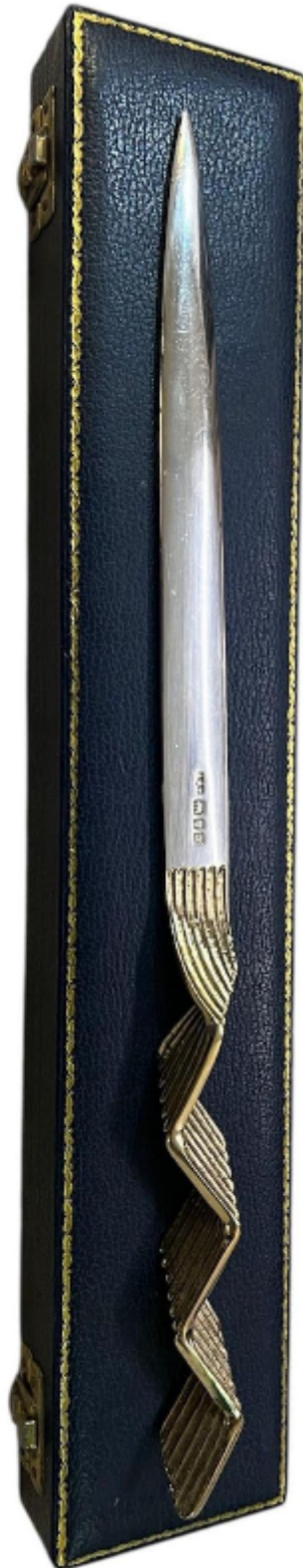


Solid Silver Letter Opener - London - 1986 by Grant MacDonald
